INTRODUCTION

e- procurement is an innovative method of processing procurement through electronic media. The procurement is done by inviting tenders, receiving bids, and evaluating the bids online. All the activities connected with the procurement are performed online, using the electronic media.

Some of the states like Andhra Pradesh have introduced e-procurement to bring in healthy competition, greater transparency in procurement methods. It was first introduced, in public works department to streamline the tendering process, and later extended to all departments. Now it is also implemented in few other States, like Gujarat, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Tamilnadu and many other States are also planning to introduce e-procurement.

It is observed that e-procurement lead to very healthy competition resulting in highly competitive bids, besides transparency.

With this background, ESCI is organizing this training programme on e-procurement, to familiarize the practicing professionals with the principles & methodology of e-procurement.
